### PETAR KASSAL



Petar Kassal is Associate professor at the University of Zagreb, Faculty of Chemical Engineering and Technology, where he is currently also Head of the Department of General and Inorganic Chemistry. He obtained his PhD in chemistry from the same institution in 2015, after a short training at the University of California San Diego, working on mobile and wireless (bio)chemical sensors. His research encompasses electrochemical and optical sensor and biosensor development, electroanalysis, environmental chemistry, wearable sensors, smart bandages, and functional nanomaterials. He has co-authored 24 publications, cited over 1000 times. Petar Kassal is recipient of the National Science Award of the Republic of Croatia, the institutional Ivan Plotnikov award for best young scientist, as well as multiple innovation awards. He is a board member of the Croatian chemical society, and a member of the Croatian society of chemical engineers and the International Society of Electrochemistry.
